#### Pancake Breakfast

You are invited to a Pancake Breakfast on January 25th from 8:30-11:30 a.m. in the MPR lower level of the church



The breakfast will include pancakes, sausage, and orange Juice. A "free will donation" will go to the Downtown Daily Bread in Harrisburg (downtowndailybread.org). This is a mission project of Pine Street Presbyterian Church, founded on March 23, 1983, and is a walk-in resource center for all hungry and homeless individuals. Additionally, they need the following gently used items:

- Luggage (prefer on wheels with handle-any size even kids)
- Winter Jackets (usually men and women size small to large, down/wool as long as warm)
- Long pants (warm–jeans are good. All men and women sizes)
- Boots (Winter, weatherproof all men & women sizes) Blankets (Warm, easy to pack, preferred waterproof)
- Sleeping bags

Before donating to Community Aid or Goodwill consider bringing it to the Pancake breakfast.



**2025-26 Registration**—Registration for the 2025-2026 school year opens on January 6<sup>th</sup> when the children return after their Christmas break. Please let your friends and family know that we have openings in our 2½, 3-, and 4-year-old classes. Thank you!

Hands On Room—We will have our Hands On Room again this year beginning on January 21st. During the winter months when the children don't have the opportunity to play outside, we set up a Hands On Room in the church lounge for the three and four-year-old classes. This room contains items that the children enjoy touching, feeling, and manipulating but that would not normally be available at home or school. Parent volunteers take the children to the room in small groups to touch and experience what they see. The room begins as a business office, changes to a doctor's office, and ends as a nature preserve! The last day for the room will be February 21st.

#### **Disaster Response Stuff the Truck**

Thank you to all those who donated, volunteered and in some way helped out with the November 23rd Stuff the Truck for North Carolina event. It was a huge success! Deb Stein worked tirelessly to get the word out, via RJ and radio advertising, a newspaper ad and coordinating with other local NALC congregations. There were blankets and health kits from the Emanuel Lutheran Church Warehouse in Elmer, NJ, a large box of Bibles and 40 flood buckets from St Michaels Lutheran Church congregation in Hamburg, PA. Additionally, we were able to purchase \$250 worth of new toys with a gift card from Thrivent. Our big surprise of the day was a huge donation from Cumberland Perry Toys for Tots. They heard about the event on WHP 580 and blessed the event with a suburban and a trailer full of new toys! In all we sent a small mountain of toilet paper, flood buckets, bunches of blankets, Home Depot gift cards, and contributed a significant number (upwards of 2,000) new toys donated to date. All to bless our neighbors suffering through the aftermath of the devastating hurricanes. Our prayer is that they might have a brighter Christmas. In addition, approximately \$350 cash was donated that will go to purchase items to complete 19 more flood buckets and 20 health kits in the next couple of weeks for delivery to the warehouse in Middle River, MD by the middle of December.
